A unique way of supporting the Rochester Cathedral Campaign, and being offered only to parishes within the Diocese of Rochester, the 604 Society celebrates the foundation of the Cathedral 1402 years ago.

It presents parishes with a simple yet recognisable method of support. To become a member of the Society parishes are asked to make a donation of at least £604 over the next 4 years. This could be an annual pledge of £151 a year or it could be a one-off gift. 43 parishes have joined the Society with a total of almost £29,000 having been pledged, and we look forward to hearing from more parishes wanting to get involved.

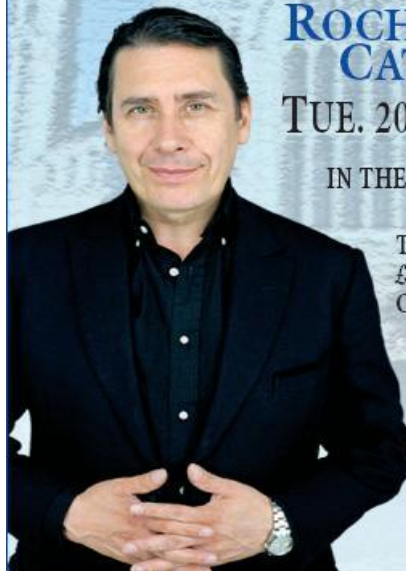
